THE EARLY YEARS EXTENDED DAY PROGRAMME

We are again offering an extended day programme for Nursery Students on the full-day programme and Reception children. The Extended Day commences at 4pm and continues until 5.00pm. The Extended Day is overseen by the Early Years Staff who are supported by High School students. The programme includes group and individual activities, which will emphasise creativity, play and adventure.

Parents should inform the Early Years Office at morning drop off of the day (or earlier) if they plan for their child to remain at school after 3.00pm. The cost is 100CZK per child per day, including a light snack. Payment is in advance to the office, but no later than the following day. Children may be picked up any time during the extended day programme.

All children who stay for Extended Day take part in a club activity from 3-4pm. You may register your child for a club with the secretary, Mrs. Lenka. If your child is not registered for a club he/she will be placed in an available club by the teacher on duty.

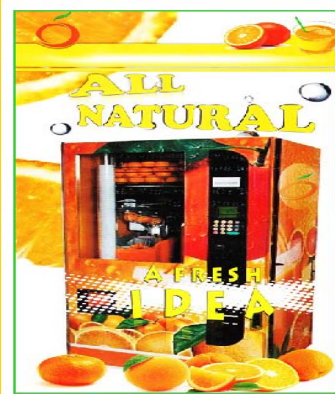
Learning Support, Year 1

Programmes have been launched as part of our Musicians for Life focus.



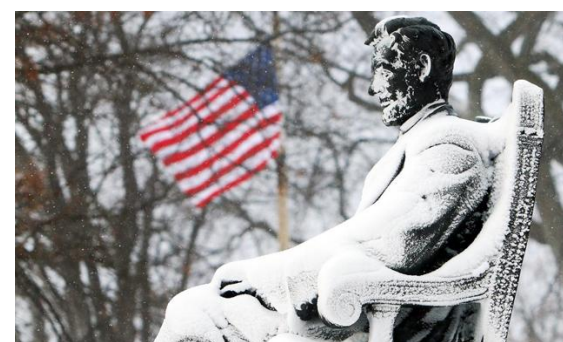
Each student has received an orchestral instrument and will

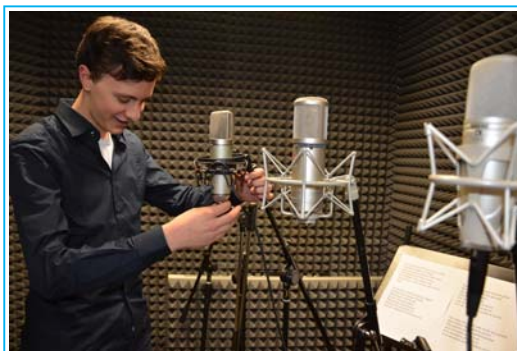
