Community and School

- Riverside is an International School for children between the ages of 3 and 18 years. The Early Years School is from 3-5 years, the Primary School from 5-11 years, the Junior High School from 11-14 years and the Senior High from 15-18 years.
- The school was founded in 1994. It is an independent, co-educational day school.
- Graduates receive a U.S. High School Diploma.
- The International Baccalaureate Diploma is also available.

Philosophy

Riverside School has an underlying Christian ethos which is attractive to families of all faiths and of none. The warm family atmosphere is conducive to high academic standards.

Accreditation

Riverside School is fully accredited with the New England Association of Schools and Colleges, the Council of International Schools and the Council of British International Schools. It is also authorized by the International Baccalaureate Organization to offer the IB Diploma Program.

Affiliation

- Riverside is in membership with the European Council of International Schools, the Independent Schools Christian Alliance and the Independent School Commission. It is recognized by the United Kingdom, Department of Education and Skills Dfes No 70/36271 and by the Czech Republic Ministry of Education Cj. 35229/1999-22. It is an International Centre for the University of Cambridge International Examinations Ref. CZ026.
- Riverside School is a designated school for the US Department of State Office of Overseas Schools in Prague.

Enrolment

- The school currently enrolls 530 students; of which 159 are in the Senior High School. There are 30 students in the class of 2016. The students represent over 40 nationalities.
- Class sizes range from 12-16 in the High School with a student-teacher ratio of 7:1.
- Approximately 90% of graduates attend a 4 year university

Faculty

- There are 20 full-time and 8 part-time teachers in the High School with an average of 14 years of teaching experience.
- All teachers hold university degrees and are certified from the UK, US, Canada, Australia or New Zealand.

Curriculum

- Riverside School offers a broad international curriculum based on the National Curriculum of England adapted to the needs of an international student body.
- Instruction is in English. Intensive English courses offer a support system for those students who require it.
- All academic courses are university preparatory level.
- All grade 9 and 10 courses are IGCSE courses with examinations held at the end of grade 10.
- Riverside offers the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program.
- All courses offered in grades 11-12 are IB courses.
- Students who do not pursue the full IB diploma work towards earning a High School Diploma.

Extra-curricular

Skills for Life activities include music groups, Model United Nations, community service, Student Council, visual and performing arts (dance and drama), sports, International Award Program an extensive Outdoor Adventure program and a membership at a local fitness avm.
