We are very pleased that your child is interested in participating in the *Outward Bound* Winter Camping trip. This trip is a unique opportunity that will help your son/daughter grow in their confidence, problem solving and leadership skills, as well as allow them to experience something completely new!

On **Thursday February 18th to Friday February 19th 2016**, students will go on an overnight excursion to Horni Maxov where they will build snow shelters called Quincys, and sleep in them. They will also participate in a variety of activities, the main one being a dogsled training program where each student will learn how to, and get to try driving a dogsled! This excursion has a fee of 2000 Kc. This covers all transport, food and activity gear as well as the dogsled training program. Students will depart on **Thursday from Riverside School at 8:00 am**, and return in the evening on Friday at 5 pm.

At the site, students will have instruction on how to build proper Quincys and will be given a few hours in the morning to begin building. We will have lunch outdoors around the campfire and after lunch students will participate in cross-country skiing. When they return, students will carve out their Quincys. That evening we will have dinner indoors at a nearby restaurant. Overnight, students will be challenged to spend the night in their Quincy, but there will be a heated house available if they become too cold. The next day we will have breakfast by the fire, and begin our dogsled program put on by our host: Jana Lovette Henychová, a long time professional dog sled racer and trainer.
