Community and School

- Founded in 1994. Independent, co-educational day school for children between the ages of 3 and 18 years.
- Non-profit school serving the international community by offering education of an excellent quality with English as the language of instruction.
- Riverside is known for its high academic standards, excellent facilities and development of the whole child.
- Riverside School has an underlying Christian ethos which is attractive to families of all faiths and of none. The warm family atmosphere is conducive to high academic standards.

Students

- The school currently enrolls 650 students representing over 50 nationalities. There are 224 students in the Senior High School (Years 10-13/Grades 9-12) with 53 students in the Class of 2023.
- Non-selective enrolment with class sizes ranging from 5-16 in the High School and a student-teacher ratio of 7:1.
- Approximately 90% of graduates attend a 4 year university.

Academic Program

- Riverside School offers a broad international curriculum based on the National Curriculum of England adapted to the needs of an international student body.
- All academic courses are university preparatory level.
- Most Year 10 and 11 (Grade 9 and 10) courses are IGCSE courses with examinations held at the end of Year 11.
- Riverside offers an accredited American High School Diploma and the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program.
- Years 12 and 13 (Grades 11 and 12) take two-year IB courses.
- Students who do not pursue the full IB diploma work towards earning IB certificates and a High School Diploma.
- High School Graduation is on 26 May 2023.
- English is the principal language of instruction. Students complete a full program of English-language coursework and exams and qualify for university-level English-language study.

Skills for Life (Extra-curricular)

- Riverside offers a rich variety of Skills for Life (extra-curricular) opportunities including music groups, Model United Nations (MUN), community service, student council, visual and performing arts (dance and theatre), sports, DoFE Program, extensive Outdoor Adventure opportunities and a membership at a local fitness gym.
