Top Tips for Parents / Carers









1.Get involved with your child. Install and use the same Devices, Apps, Social media and Games. Get them to show you.

2. Always stick to the age guidelines & restrictions placed on the App, Social Media and online Games.

3. Keep checking on your childs online contacts / friends. Plus check the requests and notifications received by your child.

4.Be part of your childs closed Group. Games and messaging services (Fortnite, TikTok, Whats App We Chat etc) allow for closed groups to be formed.









5. It's a good idea for you and your children to cover their web cam up when not in use.

6. Don't use File Sharing Systems (eg Putlocker - 123 Movies - Solar Movie) or stream films from Google – There is a higher possibility of viruses.

7. Use Apples 'Family Sharing' on IPhones & *Ipads & Google Family* Link on Android phones and tablets to monitor and prevent your childs independent App downloads.

8. Switch off GPS & <u>Location Services</u> on all devices when not needed and only use when required.
