School and Community

- Founded in 1994. Independent, non-profit, co-educational day school for children between the ages of 3 and 18 years.
- Riverside is known for its high academic standards, excellent facilities, and dedication to the development of the whole child.
- Riverside School has an underlying Christian ethos which is attractive to families of all faiths and of none.

Students

- The school currently enrolls 730 students representing over 60 nationalities. There are 250 students in the Senior High School (Years 10–13/Grades 9–12) with 64 students in the Class of 2026.
- Non-selective environment with class sizes ranging from 7–18 in the High School and a student–teacher ratio of 7:1.
- Approximately 95% of graduates attend a 4-year university.

Academic Program

- Riverside School offers a broad international curriculum based on the National Curriculum of England and adapted to the needs of an international student body.
- Riverside offers an accredited American High School Diploma and the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program.
- Most Year 10 and 11 (Grade 9 and 10) courses are IGCSE courses with examinations held at the end of Year 11.
- All academic courses are university preparatory level.
- High School Graduation is on 29 May 2026.
- English is the principal language of instruction and exams, as a result of which students qualify for university-level English language study.

Skills for Life (Extra-curricular)

- Riverside students complement their classroom learning with a rich variety of Skills for Life opportunities, including music groups, Model United Nations (MUN), community service, student council, visual and performing arts (dance and theatre), sports, DoE Program, extensive Outdoor Adventure programs and a membership at a local fitness gym.

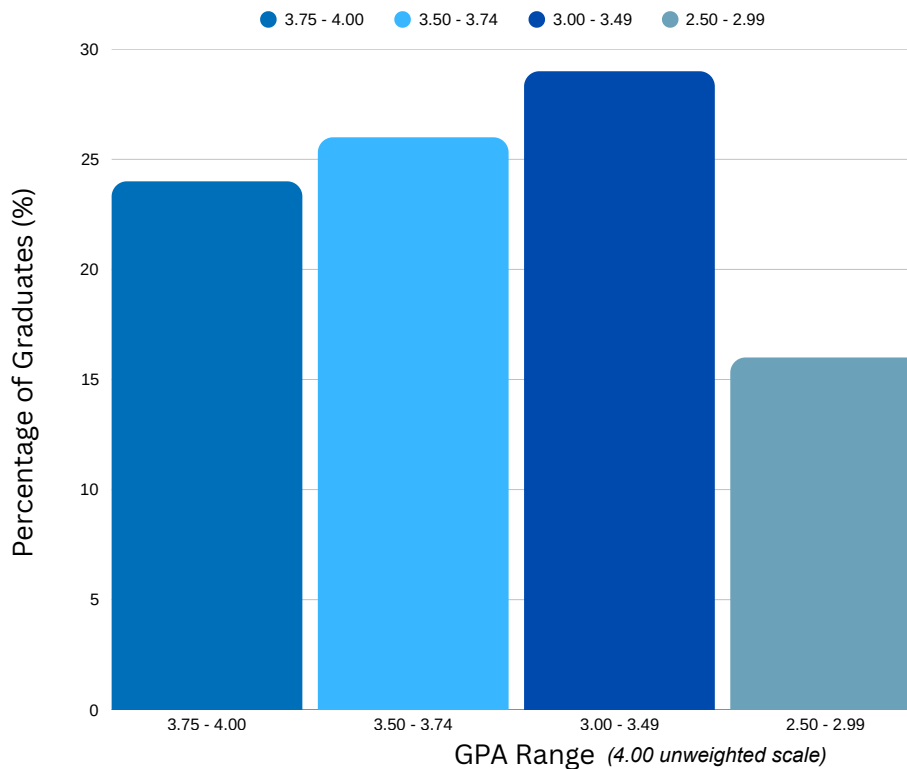
GPA and Class Rank
